Requirements for Louisiana Reciprocal Auctioneer Licensing

To be considered for a Reciprocal Auctioneer License you must reside AND be currently licensed as an Auctioneer in Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Mississippi, North Carolina, Ohio, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, Virginia, or West Virginia. Please use this checklist to ensure that you have complied with all requirements. Mail the application and attachments to the address above.

Louisiana has an Auction Business licensing requirement. If your auction business is entering Louisiana to hold auctions, you must also have an Auction Business license. You are exempt from this licensing requirement if you are a sole proprietor of the business and reside AND are currently licensed as an Auctioneer in Arkansas, South Carolina, or Texas.

 _Application form (3 pages): completed, signed and notarized
 _Oath of office form: completed, signed and notarized
 _Irrevocable Consent Form: signed and notarized
 Proof of Citizenship: Submit a Notarized copy of your voter registration card, U.S. passport, or Birth Certificate. Legal Alien- submit a certified copy of your green card.
 Letter of Good Standing from your home state certifying you currently hold an auctioneer license – screen prints from your licensing state's website are <i>not</i> accepted.
 Obtain and submit a Surety Bond in favor of the Louisiana Auctioneers Board in the Amount of \$10,000. The Bond must be issued in your name, not a business name. All bonds must run concurrent with the licensing period ending December 31 st . Multi-year bonds are accepted. The original must be submitted. Be sure to sign your bond.
 _Submit proof from the Louisiana Department of Revenue that you are registered to pay Louisiana sales tax or sign the sales tax waiver on the application. You may apply online and submit the confirmation page.
 _Submit a passport size headshot taken within the past 6 months
 Fees: check, money order, or credit card payable to the Louisiana Auctioneers Board for \$300 OR if you reside in Florida you must pay \$330; if you reside in Georgia you must pay \$350. These fees are set by the Reciprocal Agreement between the states involved. If you were previously licensed in Louisiana and your license has been expired for more than 12 months, you must pay the additional \$100 license restoration fee.

All license applications are considered at regularly scheduled board meetings. Applications are due 2 weeks before the board meeting. Please visit our website to view board meeting dates. It is not necessary to be present at the board meeting. Upon approval, your licensing information will be mailed to you. Need a license sooner? Please contact the office immediately.

Please note all licenses run January 1st through December 31st. License fees are not pro-rated and are non-refundable.
